### Got skates? Ruby's Diner has a job for you

Ruby's Diner is hiring about 135 workers for its new Five Points Drive-In, which is soon to open in Anaheim — and if you can skate you may have an edge.



It's Ruby's first ever drive-in and the restaurant is looking for regular servers, roller-skating servers, bussers, hosts, fountain station operators and cooks.

If you think you're up for one of the skating carhop jobs, you need to indicate it on your application.

Roller skating server applicants "must demonstrate that they can skate well with and without a tray full of food," Ruby's says.

A tryout will be held at the Fountain Valley Skating Center. A Ruby's hiring manager will contact applicants based on their applications with dates and details about the tryout.

Altogether, Ruby's plans to hire about 100 in the front of the house and 35 back-house staff.

If you are interested, you are advised to apply in person at the Fullerton Ruby's, 1301 S. Harbor Blvd. It's open Sunday-Thursday 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Friday-Saturday hours are 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
